

## From Councillor Bas Balkissoon

Ward 41 Scarborough-Rouge River

Dear Rosewood Neighbour,

Need to clean out a garage or get rid of some home renovation material?

Every household in Toronto is entitled to dump, free of charge, up to one ton of waste each year. You can make multiple trips through the year, as long as you do not exceed the cumulative total weight of 1 ton in the calendar year.

Materials to be dumped can be loaded into your vehicle and taken to any city transfer station. Please ensure that your bulk material does not contain any hazardous waste, such as paints and chemicals, which must be handled separately. The nearest transfer station for most of Ward 41 is at 1 Transfer Place (enter from Nugget Avenue, just west of Markham Road).

To take advantage of this free dumping, you must first complete and submit a Disposal Exemption Form. Forms can be obtained by contacting my office or by going online at: [http://www.city.toronto.on.ca/exemption/exemption\\_policy.htm](http://www.city.toronto.on.ca/exemption/exemption_policy.htm)
